International Climate Initiative (IKI)

.. since 2008 finances climate and biodiversity projects in developing countries

...places clear emphasis on climate change mitigation, adaptation to the impacts of climate change and the protection of biological diversity

..aims for positive inputs for the negotiations under UNFCCC and CBD

...is a key element of Germany's climate financing

- > more than 440 projects with a **BMUB grant of 1.3 bn €**
- > ca. **3.3 bn € total turnover** incl. mobilised additional funds (by project implementers and other public and private sponsors)



Mitigation and MRV Cluster of the IKI

- 37 LEDS/Green Economy projects with a volume of 112 m €
 - 22 bilateral, 6 regional, 9 global projects



In addition:



- 23 NAMA and sector-wide approaches projects: 67 m €
- 15 MRV projects: 60 m €
- 22 Overarching/others: 80 m €



➔ ca. 100 projects with a volume of **310 m €**

Example LEDS Support II: Low Emission Capacity Building Programme (LECB) (2011-2016)

- Funded by the EU-Com, AUS and Germany (BMUB funding volume 10 m €)
- Multicountry project, implemented by UNDP in 25 partner countries with country specific programmes and strong peer-to-peer exchange
- **Objective:** Build capacities to design and implement low emission development through national mitigation actions in the public and/or private sectors.
- **A capacity building programme focussing on:**
 - GHG inventory management systems
 - Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs)
 - Low-Emission Development Strategies (LEDS)
 - Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV)
 - Participation of selected industries in mitigation actions
 - INDC Preparation Support

Example LEDS Support III: International Partnership on Mitigation and MRV (IPMM)

- Launched by ZAF, KOR, GER in 2010 it encourages countries to **step up mitigation ambition and carry out a low-carbon transformation**
- IPMM **facilitates the exchange of good practice** on mitigation-related experiences and MRV between climate negotiators, policymakers and practitioners from more than 70 developing and developed countries in order to **share learning, build trust and inform the UN Climate negotiations.**
- IPMM seeks to **enhance cooperation and exchange** with various partners through its regional groups (African, Asian, LAC Regional Group, Cluster Francophone) **on the following topics:**
 - Low-Emission Development Strategies (LEDS);
 - Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions (NAMAs);
 - Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs);
 - Measuring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) systems.
